Mr. Kapur's presence in school has always had magical effects on all the students— our faces always lit up when we met him, eager to listen to what he had to say. He is also on the prestigious Board Of Governors of 'The Doon School' and 'Scindia School' and has expanded his philosophy to other countries like Oman and Bhutan- recently receiving the 'Druk Thuksey' Award-one of the highest civilian honours given by His Majesty, the King of Bhutan. We wish him the very best in his future endeavours. Vasant Valley School is indeed lucky to be associated with such a man.

While he may not be physically present in school now, we know his influence and ideology will forever remain in every stone and brick that makes up these walls and more importantly in us, the students. 
